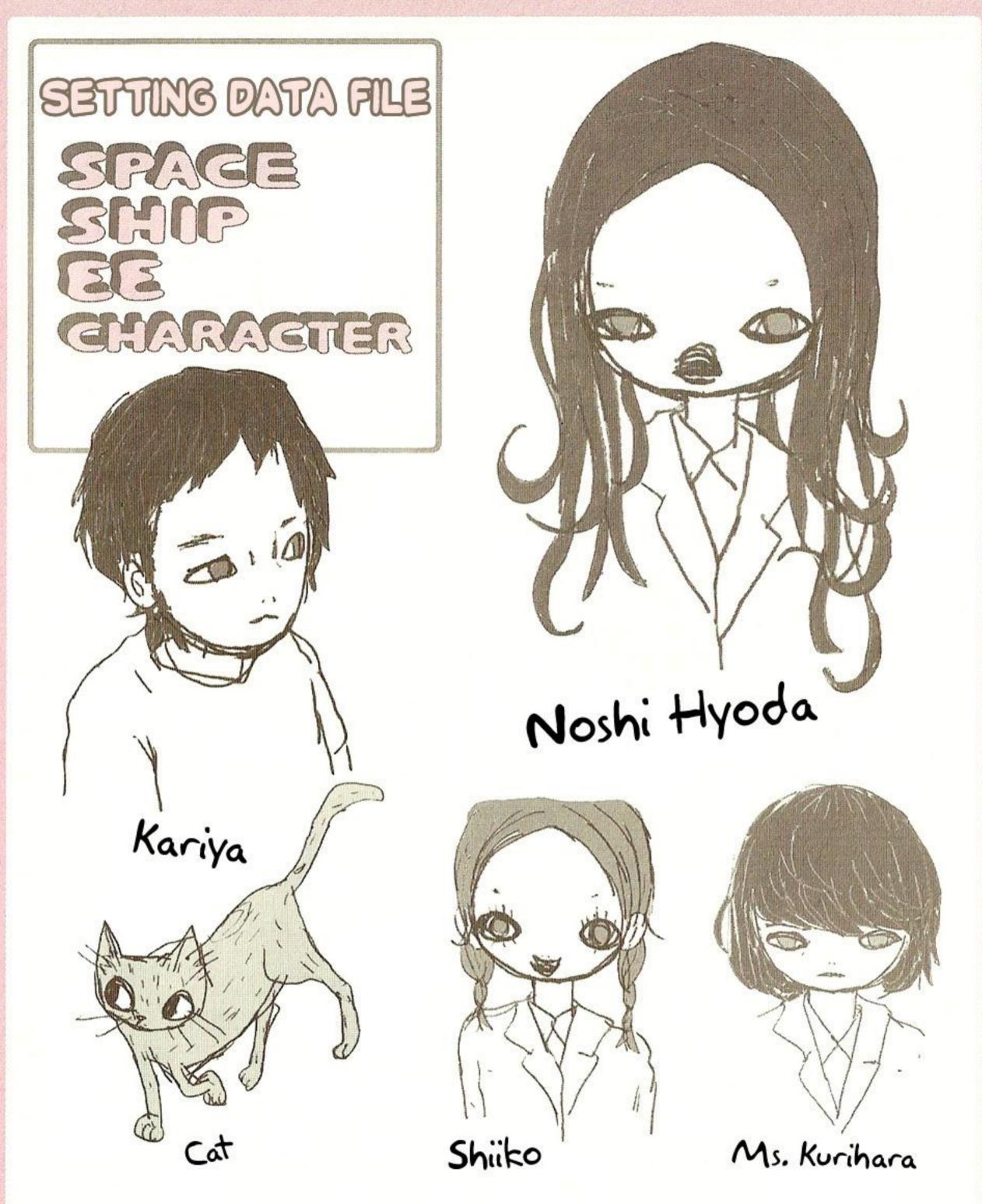












Noshi: 23-year-old office worker. She is in Admin. She is famous (in some quarters) for her talent at playing arcade games; she might be the strongest player in the country. She also likes swimming (she is not very good) and Kendama (she is awe-some at it).

Kariya: He is a designer at a company that deals with Noshi's company, and he is Noshi's boyfriend. He is also a little popular (only a little) with the female staff at Noshi's company.

Cat: Noshi and Kariya's pet. Female, about 6 years old. She was picked up as a stray (rather, she was coaxed into staying). She is actually called "Ninniku".

Ms. Kurihara: An office worker and Noshi's senior. In reality she worried over Noshi but she never conveyed this to her.

Shiiko: Noshi's junior in the office. 20 years old. She has convinced herself that she is Kariya's girlfriend.



Meg: 13-year-old girl. EE crew member. She works in Engineering and is in fact quite skilled. As the youngest child, she was brought up indulgently.

Teru: It lives with Meg but comes from a different race than the EE crew. Very Kind and helpful. There is a rule onboard the EE that children must leave their parental home and live alone from the age of 8 to 15. Meg met Teru when she was 9 years old and has lived with it since.

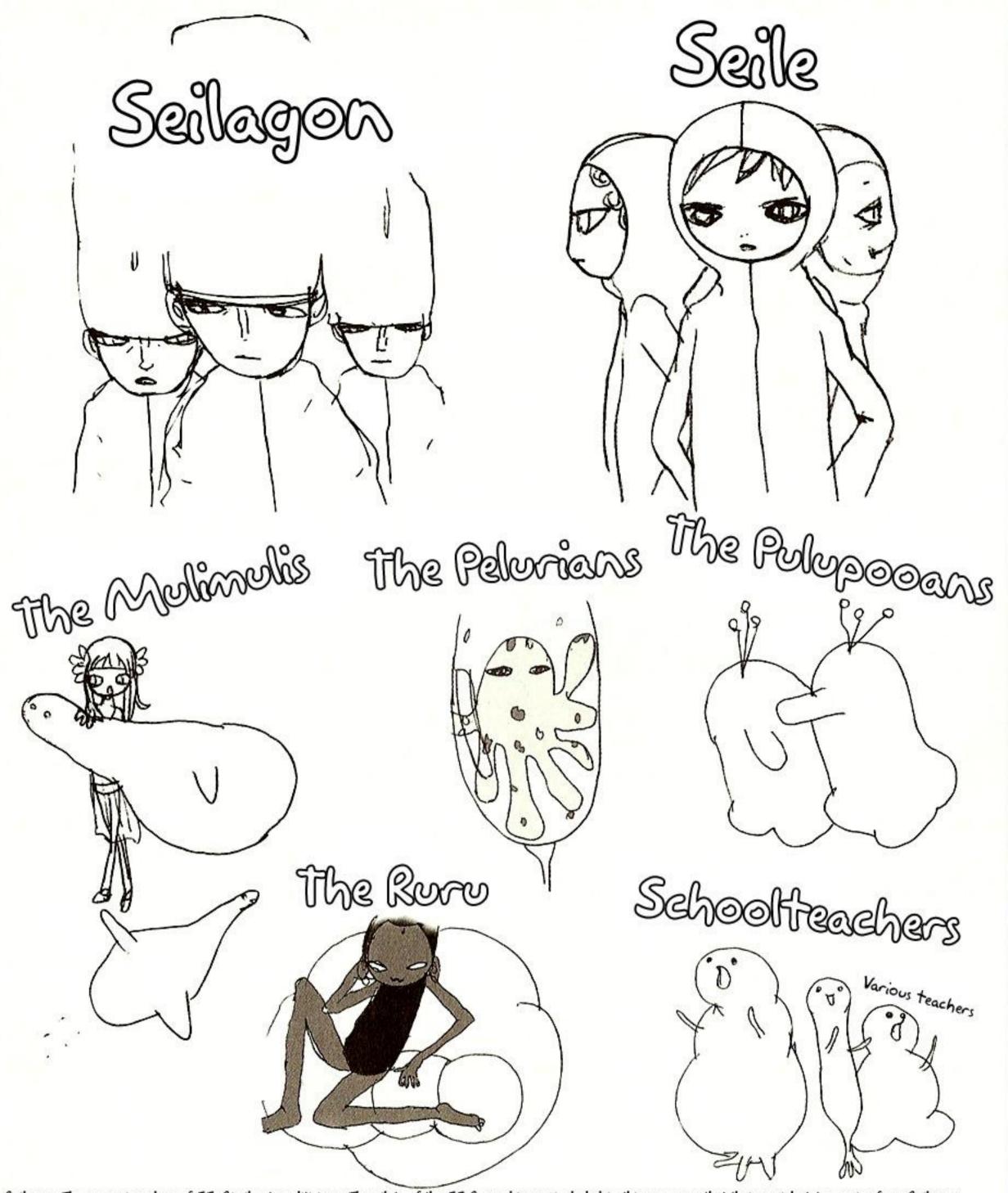
Yama: 14-year-old boy. Meg is in awe of him. Currently he is training to be a Seile (policing job). He is a second son.

Taitai: A 13-year-old girl who lives next door to Meg. She loves parties. They are childhood friends although she dislikes Meg. She sometimes earns money cooking for aliens, but usually she works in Administration.

Meg's sister: She seems indifferent and does not say much, but she is a responsible person. She constantly cooks for the aliens. Her regular job is chef to the Seilagon.

Meg's mother: Meg's mother. She loves Meg and is always ignoring people. 35 years old.

Meg's father: 38 years old. Meg's father. He did not appear even once here but he is the sort of man who will immediately speak his mind in a very loud voice.



Seilagon: The governing class of EE. Similar to politicians. The pilots of the EE Spaceship are included in this group so that their social status varies from Seilagon to Seilagon.

Seile: The EE's equivalent of a police organization. In EE, most Seile are women and the elderly. They possess stupendous abilities and are actually more revered by the population than the Seilagon.

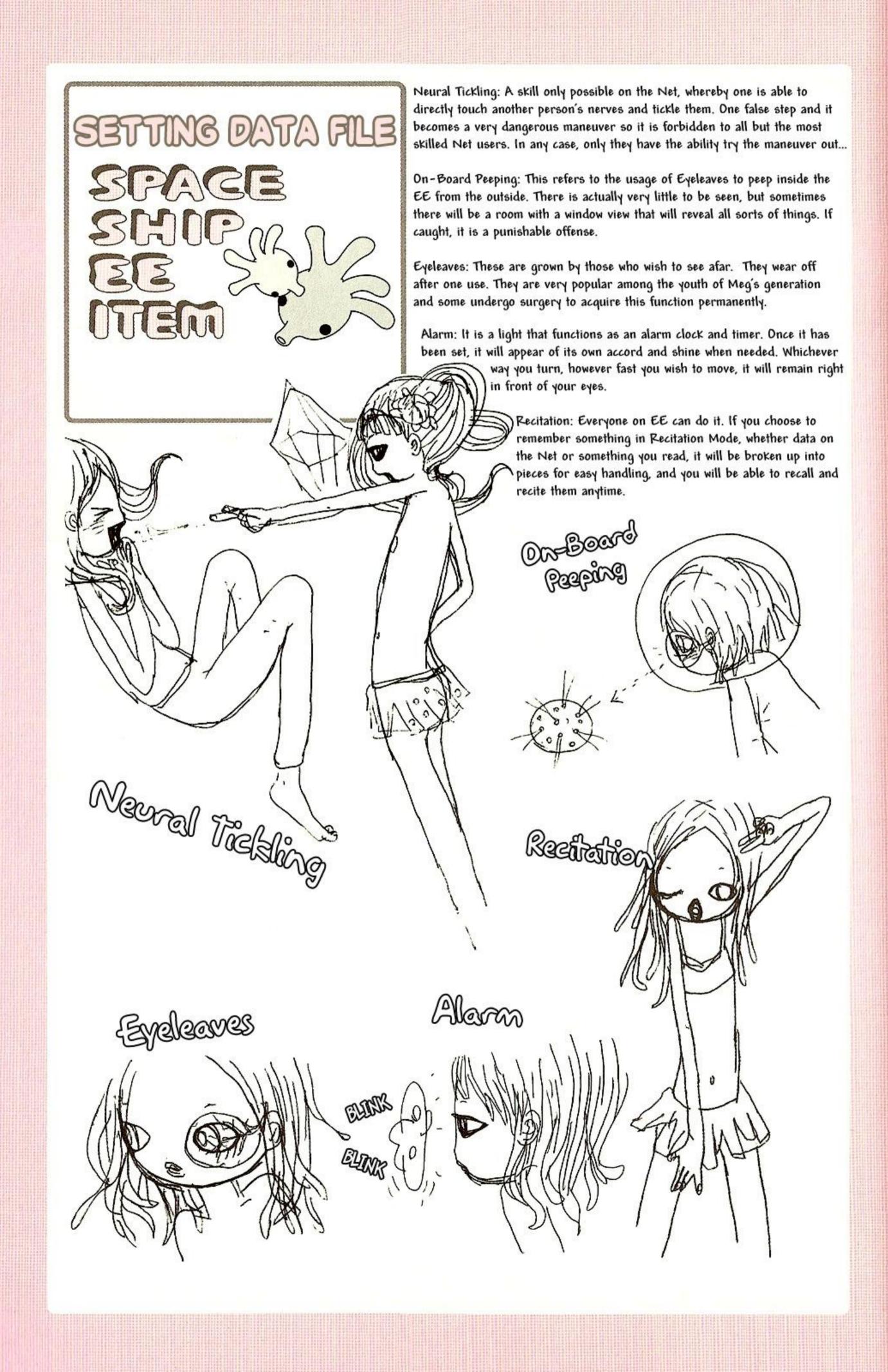
The Mulimulis: One of the more popular riding creatures in EE. Like horses, if you mount them without first becoming friendly with them they tend to disobey your commands. They were taken from another planet. They can take any shape or form.

The Pelurians: In the past they were a strong race that plunged the entire universe (as far as the Net extends) into fear and despair. They were continually warring and invading until their weak point (a certain vegetable) was discovered and they were brought under control. They are still a dangerous race and it is an abomination to even trade with them.

The Pulupooans: They brought Noshi and Kariya to Earth. They are an extremely numerous race so wherever they go they end up being an overwhelming majority. They live by transporting goods from one corner of the universe to another. A Pulupooan living peacefully in a single place does not exist.

The Ruru: Prophetic aliens. Their predictions are 100% accurate. An ancient race that became extinct in the past; since various planets desired their services, three Rurus have been successfully resurrected. All three escaped, but the rumor that one of them lives inside EE has spread far and wide. Very few have ever seen a Ruru.

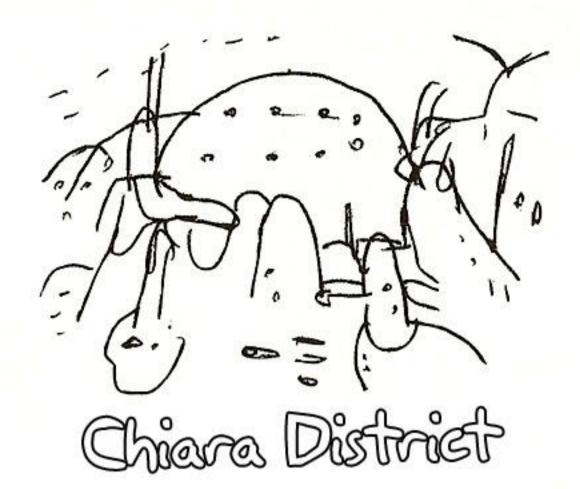
Schoolteachers: Their true form is humanoid. However, in order to dissuade students from becoming too familiar with or developing feelings for them, they adopt this shape over the Net.

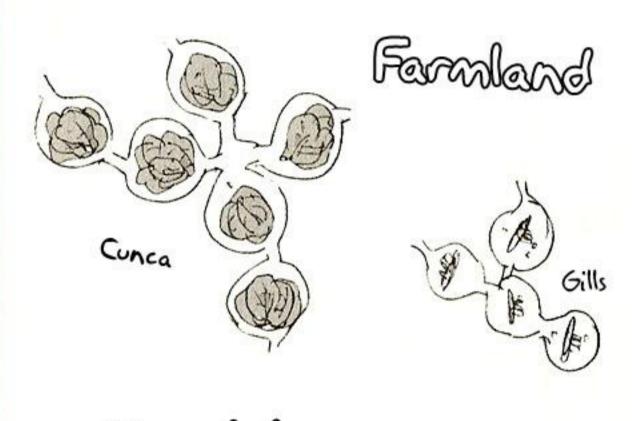


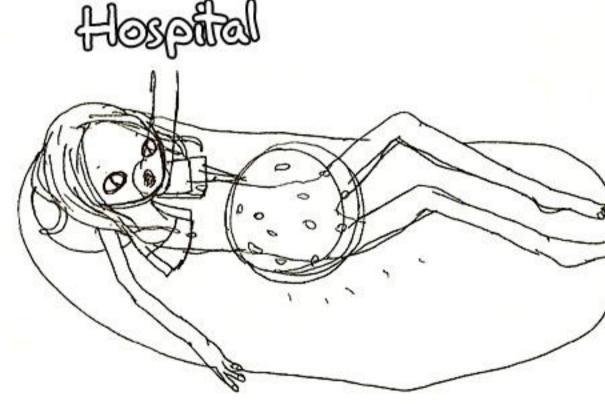


# STRUGTURE OF EE Residential Area Residential Area Ball where Meg lives Seilagon Facilities

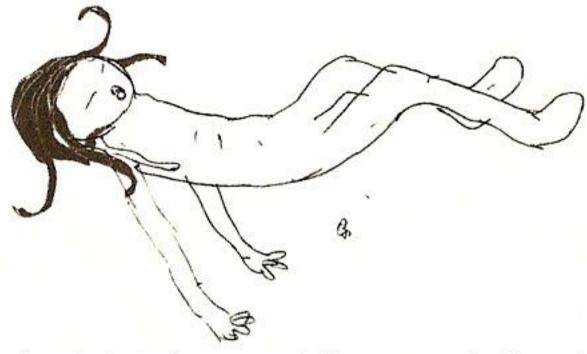
Structure of EE: As was stated at the beginning, the secrets of EE's mechanism and proper knowledge of how to service the ship have sunk into oblivion. Even so, the basic laws of operation have been handed down, so the ship is still capable of travel. What power propels the ship, where is this power located— these are total mysteries. There is no night on EE and it is always bright. The exception to this rule is Chiara District, where there are many dark areas (because the buildings are so crowded together).

Chiara District: No one knows its dimensions exactly. The most exciting neighborhood is also very scary. It is believed that tens of thousands of illegal aliens reside here. A breeding ground for crimes and criminals, it hosts the best restaurants on the ship. It is extremely dangerous for young women like Meg to stay there very late.

Farmland: Fruits and vegetables are mostly grown in jelly-form inside tubes. The produce Noshi and friends work on resembles cabbages, but it's actually a fruit with a delicious, bittersweet taste (named cunca).

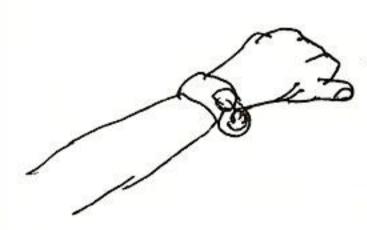
Hospital: Usually patients entering a hospital on EE are made to wear this sort of clothing and lie down in this manner, regardless of their ailment. External wounds heal almost instantaneously in comparison with Earthlings'.

Economy of EE: There is not physical form of money (coin or paper) on EE. The EE government supplies a number of points (very few!) on a monthly basis and this is added to the prior month's balance. The transaction is performed on the Net. It is possible to increase points by working harder. Whenever you want something, you trade points for it.

Stow IV's Law: Throughout the bounds of the entire universe known through the Net, the following law is in force: anyone finding a vessel that has been clearly shipwrecked must render it immediate assistance. This law was enacted by Stow the Fourth.

Dropout Rune: As a general rule on EE, anyone marking a room with this symbol will never return to enter it again.

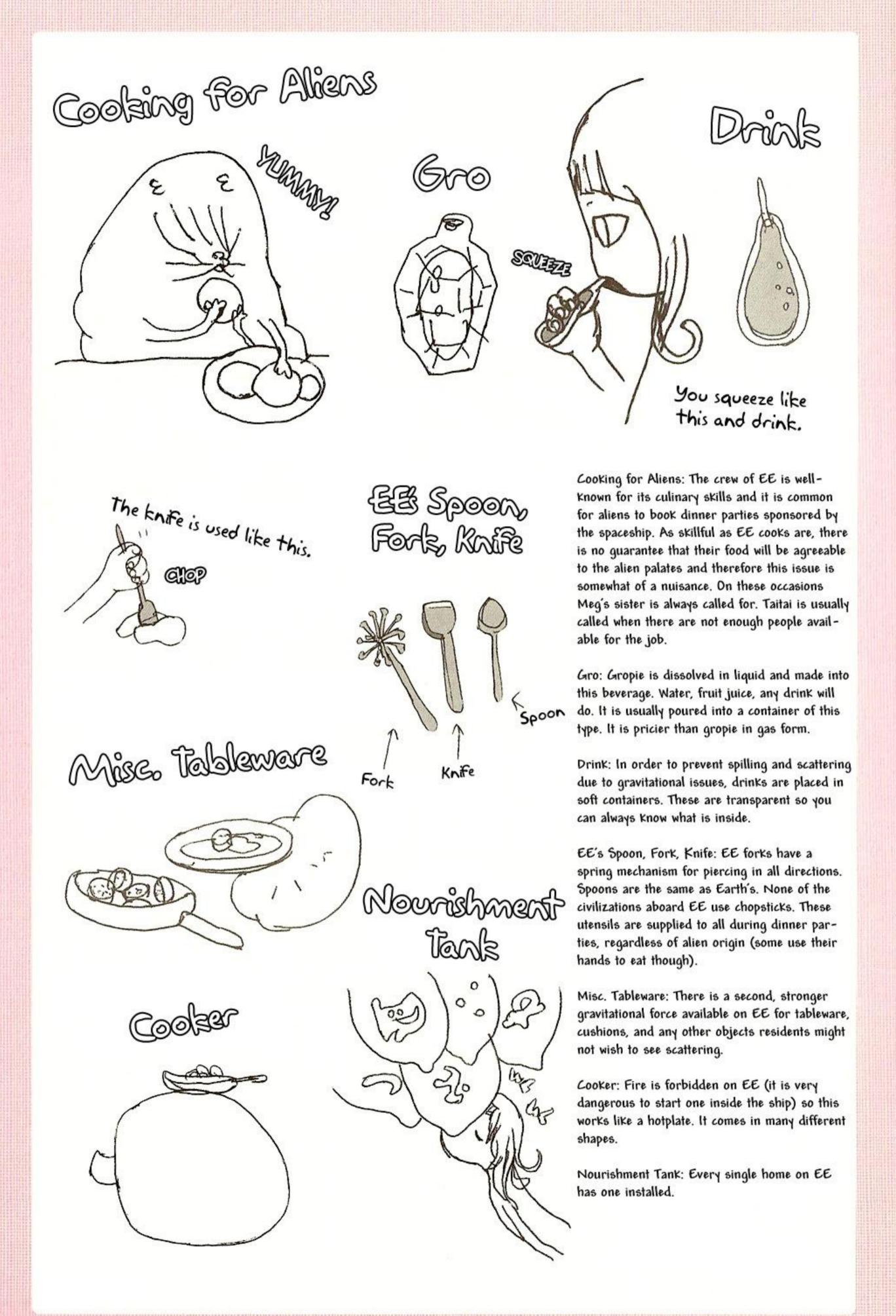

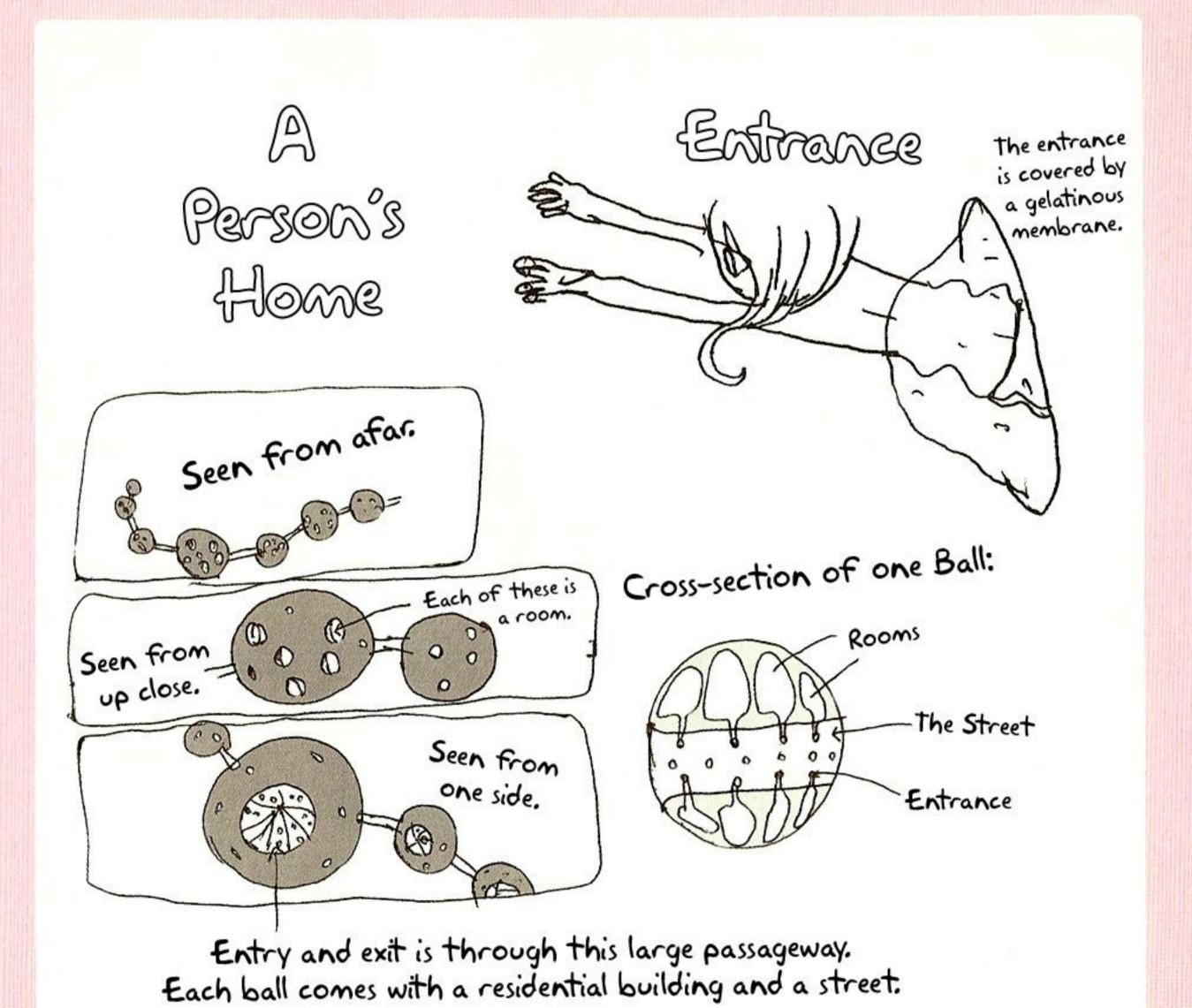

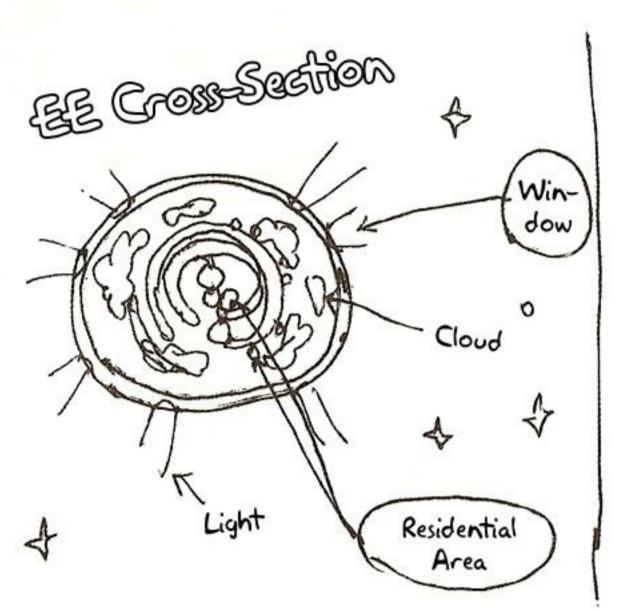








## Personal Room Window



Personal Room Window: The vast majority of the rooms on EE are not next to the outer wall of the spaceship, so in reality, the windows cannot show outer space. However, the window in each room comes equipped with a system that shows the actual space scenery in real time as if it were there. If you turn the switch off, the real view from the window will appear.

Bath: When you enter the bath, hot water begins to come out of a particular hole. The hot water gathers itself into a ball and the bather is supposed to place himself in the middle of it. If you add "doctor fish" to the water, they will poke and nibble at any injured parts of your body and heal you ("doctor fish" are fine with the hot water, and they resemble the fish of the same name in Turkey).

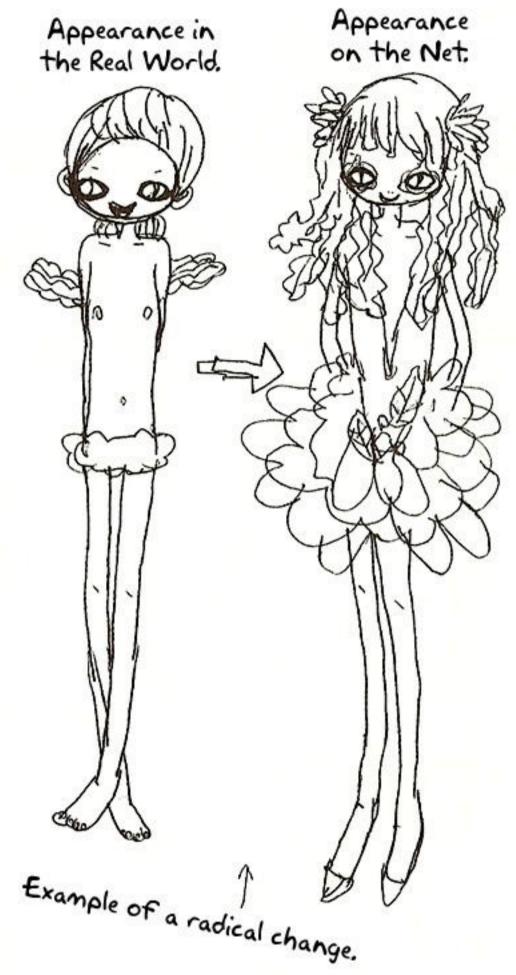
After collecting the "doctor fish", you can let the hot water go out of the same hole.

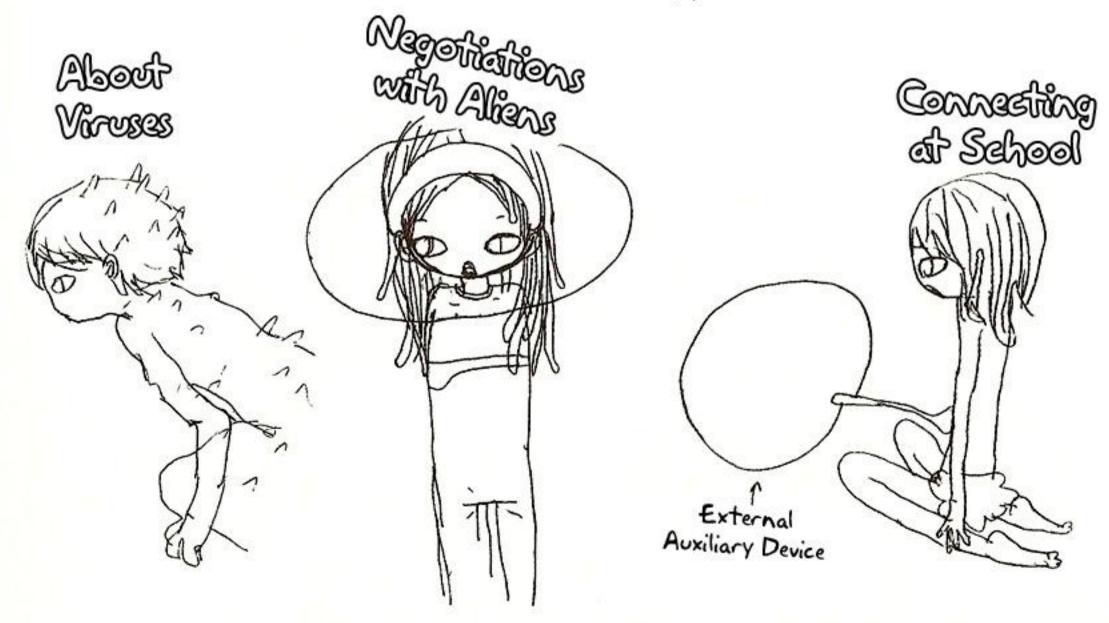
About Clothes and Makeup on the Net: There is a system of private rooms on the Net (anyone can make them once they've learned how). Once you are there, you will usually be asked by an Artificial Intelligence for the sort of clothes and makeup you would like to go out with (some people make their own programs and bypass the A.I.). Meg does not change much, but there are some who change radically. As a rule it is not allowed to alter one's face and/or body type, but there is illegal software for just this purpose. Not many people use this software, however.

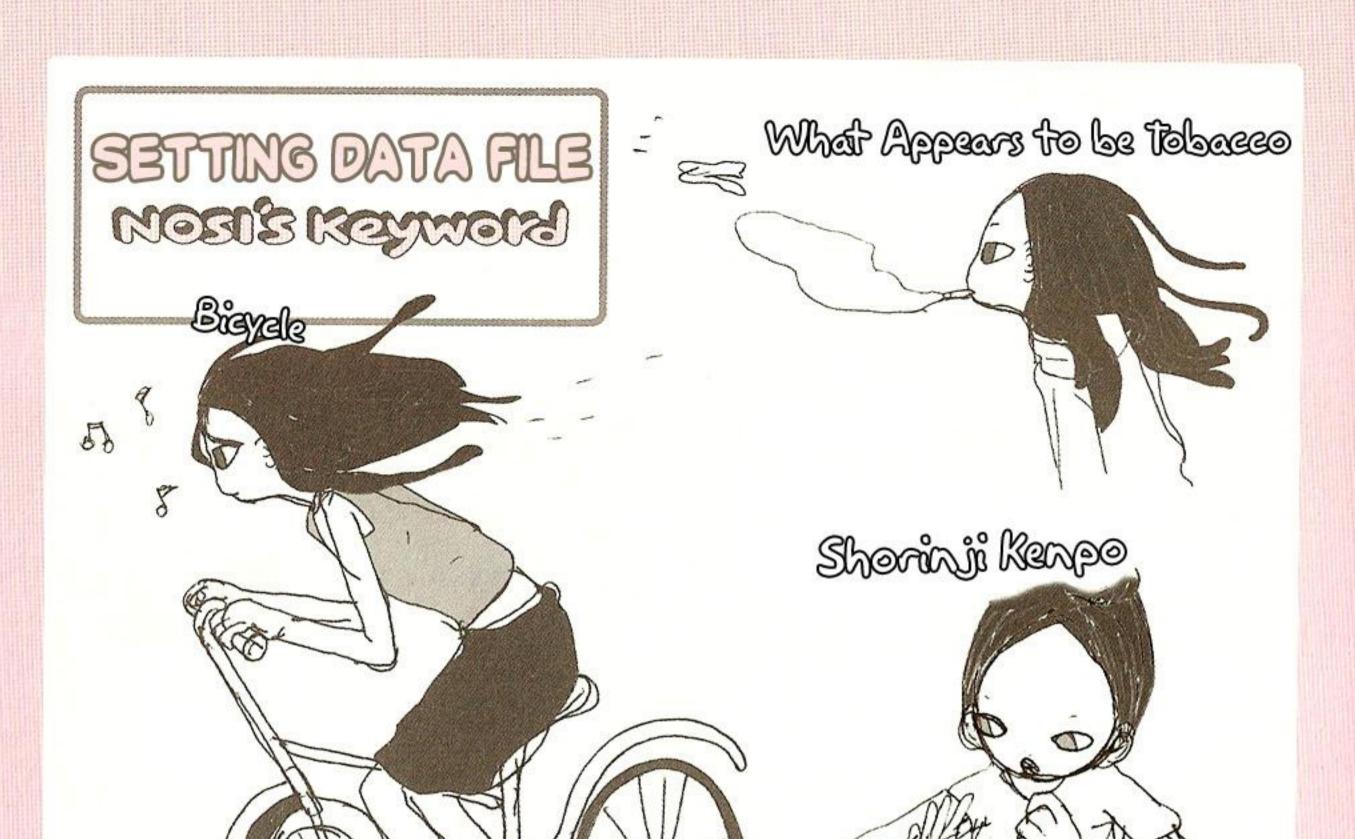
Training: This refers to battle training, which takes place in a mock space, without connecting to the Net. The opponents are all imaginary without real bodies. The only point in which it differs from actual battle is the fact that the trainee cannot die.

Negotiations with Aliens: Arrangements are made over the Net in advance of the EE's actual contact with a planet. Therefore, there is not much to talk about when the official negotiations take place. Most of the negotiations are merely formalities and nothing more. As for the clothing worn on these occasions, it consists of the EE uniform with an antiquated speech translator (like those that were used in the old days) attached to it. In the consciousness of the residents of EE, this combination evokes a deep sense of tradition.

About Viruses: The causes and remedies for the many viruses that spring up on the Net are various, but the most widespread virus on EE at the moment is one that denies infected users access to the Net. If not handled properly, the situation might become serious enough to force the user to undergo surgery in order to repair it.

Connecting at School: There is an external auxiliary device provided at school to prevent connections to the Net from being cut (usually the people of EE can connect to the Net without using machines). In addition, when the school releases a large volume of data, you can store it on this device.





What Appears to be Tobacco: Noshi is actually smoking marijuana. In the 50th year of Heisei, tobacco was banned and marijuana was legalized.

Shorinji Kenpo: Noshi is studying these martial arts. At this point, she has attended lessons three times. She had wanted to learn for a long time but she never had enough money for it. During that period, she studied on her own by reading books on the subject and researching it online.

Bicycle: Bicycles went completely out of use for awhile.

Afterwards, they were brought back in order to help the environment by increasing the use of human power.

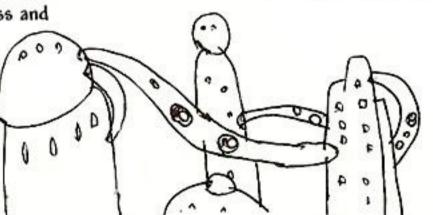
Noshi really digs bicycles.

Noshi's Company: A stable blue-chip conglomerate.
This was the company Noshi was aiming for from the very beginning. It is in the food products business and it has a long and rich history.

Architecture and Roads of Noshi's Era:
The greater part of buildings are still made of reinforced concrete, the roads of concrete.
However, already semi-transparent buildings made of plankton (good for its elasticity) and aerial roads account of 30% of the urban landscape.

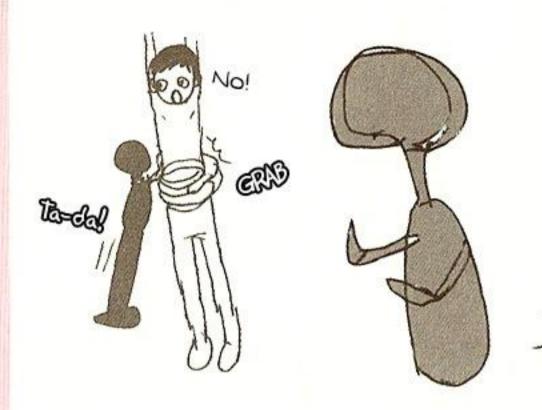


These are the vehicles design for use on aerial roads.

## Odd Machines



This dudds official rams is Security Guard-Enhanced Model. Noshi's Disguise: With the wig, hat, and clothes, she is taken for a man— or so Noshi thinks. In fact, most people can tell that it is a woman. Even in the office, there are people who know about this (but Noshi is sure nobody knows).

The Game Noshi Plays: It is called "Virtual Fighter 22" (and a total ripoff of "Virtua Fighter"). It is an evolved form of the existing "Virtua Fighter", popular as an arcade fighting game. The first part is the same as "Virtua": using a card to access the network, setting up a name, saving your battle record, etc. Other things are different: the design of the joystick and buttons, the machine's vibration, the ability to transfer a character from the computer to the arcade game, the option of taking an image of the player's face and immediately using it on a character in the game. The game looks as real as a photograph, and it is possible to modify the background: for example, by adding your own house, your school, or the place that you are actually playing in. (Recently it has become popular for players to add their teachers and favorite idols to the cast of characters. Teachers are usually raised up to be very weak, on purpose).

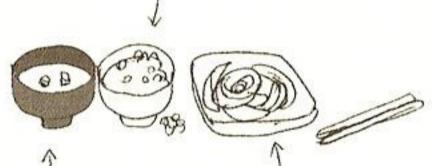
Chiba Space Center: A large-scale space center in Chiba. Most of Tapan's interplanetary traffic is handled here. It is the world's 4th largest space center.

Odd Machines: At first glance, these odd machines do not seem to be useful for anything; in this story they ended up being pretty useless but usually they are quite amazing. It is just that Noshi was too quick for them.

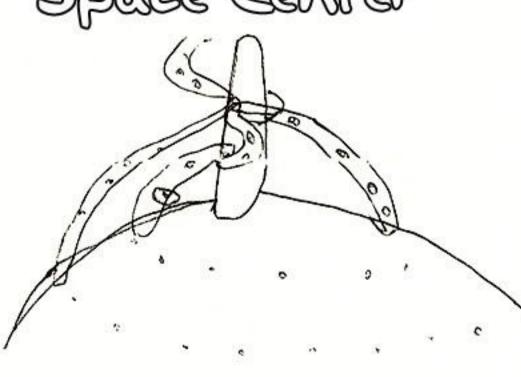

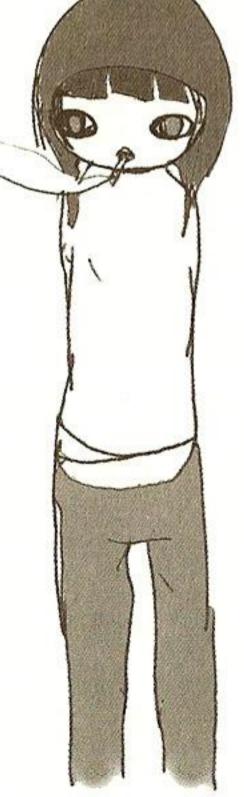

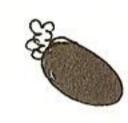

Planet Nesus

Meg's Nudism: Meg is usually completely nude when she is in her own room. This is because Meg dislikes clothes; nudism is not at all a general custom on EE. Incidentally, Meg's lack of etiquette is also a personal character trait.

Scattering of Water Drops: The reason Meg apologizes here is because when someone spills a liquid inside EE, the low gravity causes it to spread all over a room, making a general cleaning a necessity.

The Fish-Like Thing and the Eggplant-Like Thing that Meg was Cooking: As a matter of fact, EE is possesses an aquatic system akin to seas and rivers, from which it is possible to acquire fish and other seafood. Meg is a bad cook; this white meat fish is usually very tasty.

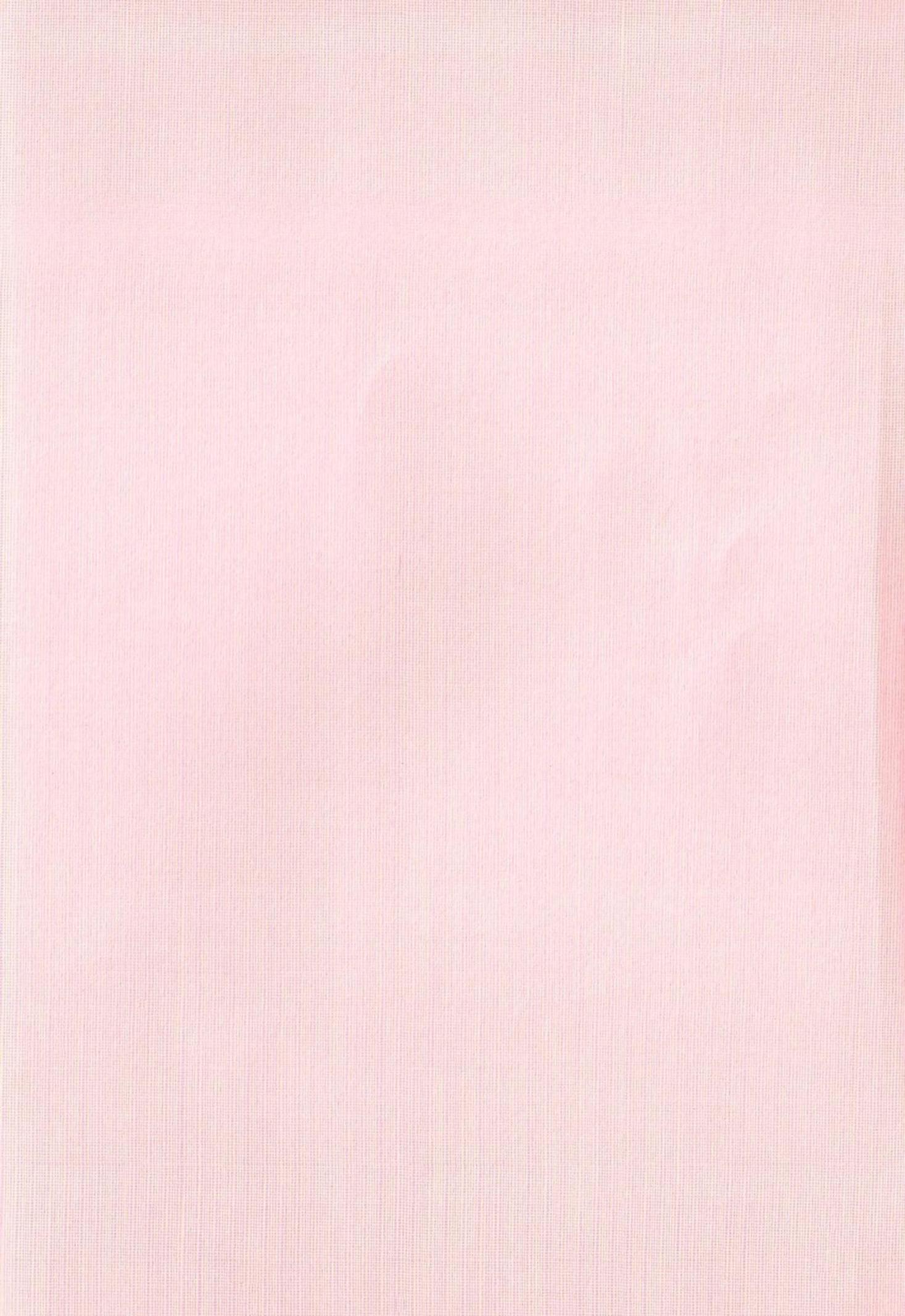
Planet Nesus: When docking at the planet Nesus, the EE shut its night doors. Meg and Yama were too late and they had to spend one night roaming the surface of Nesus. As it happened, on this night the Nesians all at once grew to

a gigantic size and dissolved into the moonlight: this event only happens every few hundred years; Meg and Yama were lucky enough to observe it.

Meteor Shower: An average resident of EE will get to see these only three or four times in a lifetime. Meg was extremely lucky to be outside the ship when one of these showers occurred. It was Meg's very first encounter with this kind of phenomenon.





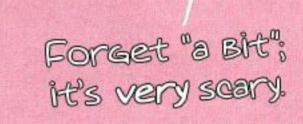


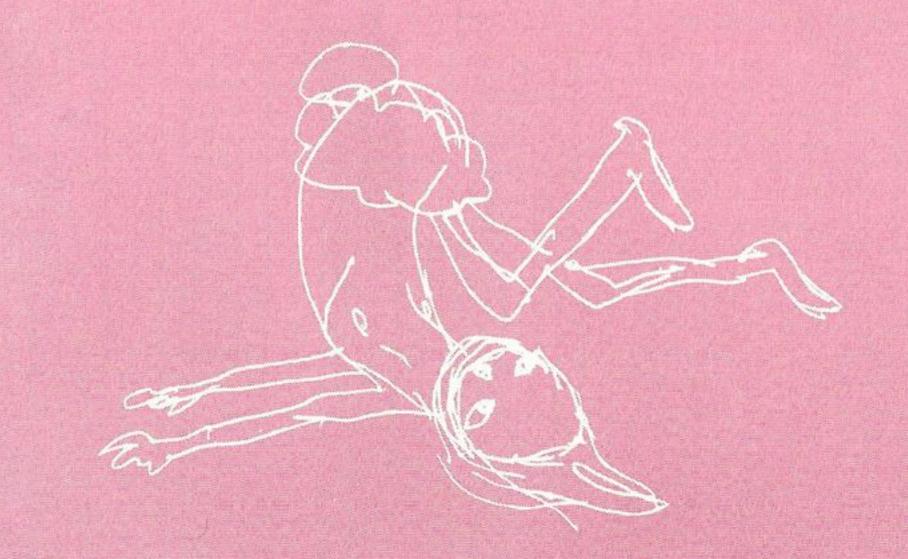
#### Postscript

"EE Spaceship" began as a webcomic (before EE Tump came along) under a penname. Meg was the protagonist in the webcomic, but after a string of jobs found and lost, I redid the whole story; out came Noshi as the main character. Several of the situations Noshi goes through in her company are based on my own experiences at the workplace. While I've adapted Noshi's character for the story, I suspect the person who I modeled her on would still recognize herself in these pages. If you read this, let me say sorry...I think you're great.

Initially, I was trying to write a fun and enjoyable sci-fi adventure story. Gradually, though, a lot of other issues began to creep in: the sense that the universe is riddled with mystery, our yearning for space and the future versus our fear of the standard, the confusion that arises when moving from one company to the next; it's all become a great, big, weird mess. After reading it myself... I can't tell if it's actually fun. I wonder what I'll feel when I read it five years from now. It's a bit scary.

## Notes from the Rabbits:

#### **AK ON TRANSLATION:**

File 13: Heisei 50 = 50th year of the reign of Emperor Akihito. 2009 = Heisei 21.

File 21: In Japanese company culture, you say something like this when you finish work. It's just a politeness ritual: literally you say: "You must be tired.", not "Nice work!"

File 67: OK, the actual word in here is人工, which means artificial. So literally, it says Estimated Artificial 220,000. I'm pretty sure this is a mistake, and the real word should be 人口 which means "population" and happens to be pronounced exactly the same way (=jinkou). I think someone messed up with the word processor there...

File 73: "Ring name" is a pro wrestler or boxer's ring name (duh) but in Japan, fighting gamers use the term as well.

File 84: I think this is simply Pamcheelian gibberish, though it looks like numbers.

File 101: Pleasure quarter, or "entertainment district", which is the more modern way to say it... I kinda like the old one better though (not to mention kimonos scream pleasure quarter...)

File 121: Kinda cryptic, but the gist of Noshi's speech seems to be that although Meg is revered and has a role to play, she's still being underestimated and could be a much more powerful being if she went down Teru's path...

File 137: Notice there's little squiggly symbols. This is the alien's File 182-183: "EE Jump" was a music duo in Japan. number sign (what number we have no clue).

File 149: The alien said 1,340 km in the last page. I don't know if this is a deliberate mistake or what...

"I'm not sure, but it's bigger than Japan."

Actually, this is somewhat bigger than Hong Kong. Japan is close to 378,000 square km. What the heck is going on? I don't know.

File 156: Meg is comparing the number of casualties involved in trying to stop the Teru people from creating a new universe with the number of people that would die if the universe was created. That is, she's trying to figure out if she should carry on fighting or give up. But the two numbers are both staggering, and the sum of the two is a great abyss!

File 161: A Little Prince moment, with the fox and the rose. Amen.

File 167: "Ninniku" means garlic.

File 173: "Gills" - Pretty darn sure that's what it says there...not sure if jelly vegetables have gills or what...

File 174: The original word for "Gro" is "munyu", which is the usual SFX for "grope" in manga so I've made it into "gropie".

#### NDE & PRETTYPROPHET ON EDITING:

prettyprophet: Yo, it's Prophet. I can't actually speak for the cleaning end, since that was all Patty and Funny (mostly Funny) so I'll just talk about what we did: script-editing and typesetting. On terms of script changes... I don't think we changed much.

nde: File 77.

prettyprophet: Oh yeah, that. Originally the guys are all, "Just like a man..." and Meg says, "The correct way!"

nde: We changed it to "Just like a male..."/"Even better!"

prettyprophet: And that was my girl-power moment. The only one, I think. Not like it really needs it.

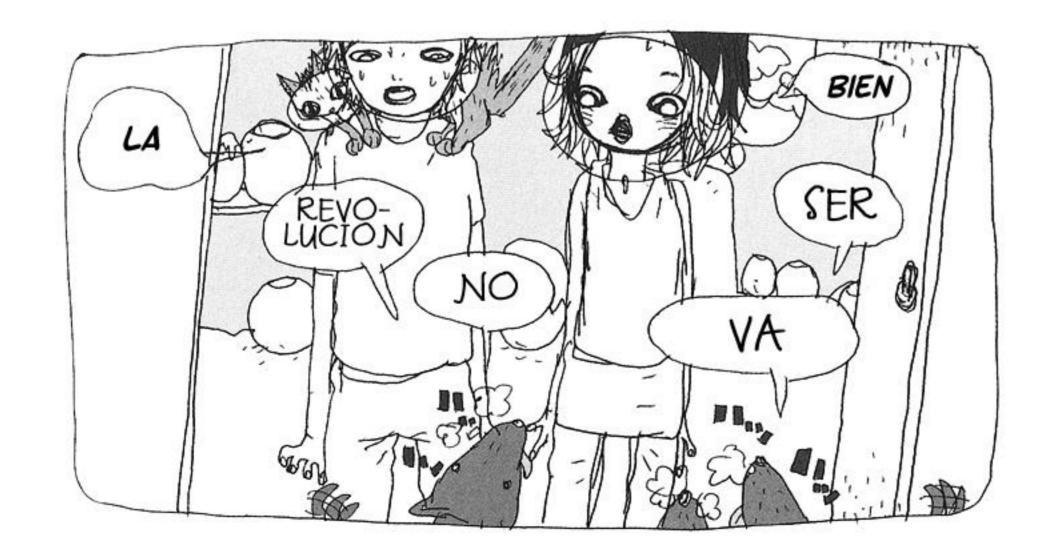
nde: Allusions.
